cleaning and TWP pays for parts. RBM Consulting \$495.00 per year, one cleaning
and parts are included.

Motion to approve the contract with RBM Consulting at the cost of \$495.00 per year if the state does not renew the contract with ES&S offered by Dean, second by B. Kelley was approved per a roll call vote 6-0.

- Scram Lake Board Rep: Larry Parker (Treasurer) offered to be the Board rep to the Scram Lake Sewer Board.
- Transportation Summit: Dean received a letter requesting our support for a county wide transit study.

Motion to not support the study or a County wide transit system offered by Dean second by B. Kelley was approved per a roll call vote 6-0

• **Community Development:** Dean explained the Township can no longer use the money on roads due to the income level of the Township residents. The Township residents have gotten little value from the home repair project.

Motion to not continue with Community Development do to excessive paperwork, lack of community interest, and the money is a loan that has to be paid back by residents offered by B. Kelley second by Matz was approved per a roll call vote 6-0
